## **Documentary Evidence – Amendments/Corrections List**

Listed below are documents that may be used as documentary evidence to amend/correct an Indiana birth record. If acceptable evidence cannot be provided, a court order will be required to amend/correct the birth record. These acceptable documents must be ten years old or more, except for children less than 10 years of age. Legible photocopies are acceptable.

- 1. <u>Baptismal certificate</u> (may perhaps be obtained from the establishment where the event occurred).
- 2. <u>Official School Records</u> (grade school entry is the most valued may be obtained from county superintendent or school office). **Must be sealed**.
  - <u>Official College Transcript</u> (may be obtained from college admissions or registrar's office). **Must be sealed**. (*Neither of these two documents may be used together or in conjunction with # 12 on this list*).
- 3. <u>Life Insurance policy/Declaration Page</u> (must state policy holder's name, insurance company name and policy number, date issued and must still be valid).
- 4. <u>Certified Proof of Marriage</u> Certified Marriage license, may be used only to amend the married individuals, Certified Application for Marriage license additional amendments. (Copies can be obtained at the county clerk's office where issued).
- 5. <u>Voter's registration card</u> (may be obtained from the county clerk's office in the county where the voter is registered).
- 6. Military Discharge (form DD214).
- 7. <u>Census record</u> (copies of census records must be obtained from the Bureau of Census. Records of past censuses are available from 1880 to 1960 (*except for 1890*).
- 8. **Employment Records** (company's acceptance letter only)
- 9. Records from a Professional Licensing Agency (usually available from the secretary of the organization).
- 10. <u>Child's Birth Record</u> (copy of birth record showing original record of birth).
- 11. <u>Hospital records of birth</u> (may be obtained from the medical records office in the hospital where the delivery occurred).
- **12.** <u>High School Diploma/College Diploma</u> (Neither of these two documents may be used together or in conjunction with # 2 on this list).
- 13. <u>Immunization Record (shot record)</u> (may be obtained via Children and Hoosier Immunization Registration Program) (CHIRP) <a href="https://chirp.in.gov/">https://chirp.in.gov/</a>.
- 14. <u>Children under 10 Years of Age</u> (birth 2 years; Notification of Birth) (2 years 6 years); Signature of parent(s) (6 years 10 years); school, medical, or immunization record.

## **NON-ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE**

Death Certificates, Driver's Licenses, State Identification, Passports, Utility Bills, Bank or Credit Card Statements, Vehicle Registration.
